100% Cabernet Franc | 2021
Region: Los Árboles y Vista Flores, Tunuyán,
Valle de Uco, Mendoza.

Vineyards: 12-year-old tall trellis, work with manual cultural labor.

Soil: alluvial sandy loam with a strong presence of round and angular stones. The interspersed layers of loose sand confer great denial to the soil. From a certain height when moving within the same vineyard, calcium carbonate is found.

Irrigation: a drip irrigation system is used, which, thanks to the permeability of the soil, we manage to control the vigor of the plant during the vegetative cycle.

Winemaking:

PH: **3,64**

Analytical data: Total acidity: **6,88** g/l

Ol: **14,2** %v/v

Height: 1,200 masl

Harvest: manual beginning of April, (depends on each year).
Maceration: pre-fermentative, cold, for approximately 5 days at 10°C in stainless steel tanks.

Fermentation: with indigenous yeasts up to 4° of alcohol, then it is inoculated with LSA until the end of the fermentation. At temperatures between 27 and 29 °C, with daily pump-overs and FML in French oak barrels.

Aging: 70% of the wine 12 months in 3rd use French oak barrels.

Guard potential: 5 years in ideal conditions.

Vinification: selected yeasts, controlled nutrition, daily pump-overs for extraction of compounds from the skin, controlled fermentation temperatures between 22 and 26 °C

Tasting Notes

Color: an attractive and imposing ruby red color stands out with purple flashes.

Nose: notes of currants, candied black fruits, menthol herbs, thyme and jarilla, roasted pepper and sweet paprika. After decanting aromas of tobacco, smoke and pepper are perceived.

Mouth: friendly entry thanks to its round, well-ripe and firm tannins. Medium acidity with medium to long aftertaste.
